§ 5101. Administration.

The Agricultural Development Services Division of the Department of Agriculture shall be the responsible body for the administration of this program.

§ 5102. Definitions.

(a) “Eligible bona fide farmer” shall mean a person registered with the Department of Agriculture who commercially grows for profit fruits, crops, herbs, ornamentals, nonedible horticulture, livestock, including aquaculture, mariculture, and/or similar products, who furnishes financial records that substantiate a claim to the Department’s satisfaction; and who is a U.S. citizen, a permanent resident alien, or who has been a resident of Guam for the immediately preceding five (5) years.

(b) “Equipment” shall mean any tool or supplies that are strictly for agricultural use.

§ 5103. Registration and Application.

In order to be eligible to participate in this program, farmers are required to register their farms with the Department of Agriculture. Registration applications must be filed with the Agricultural Development Services Division of the Department of Agriculture. Each eligible bona fide farmer who is registered according to the Department of Agriculture is required to renew the registration every year from the date of registration thereafter.

§ 5104. Purchase of Equipment.

(a) Each eligible bona fide farmer is entitled to issue one (1) order through the General Services Agency upon, or within fourteen (14) days after, the successful completion of the processing of a registration application. Each order shall be limited to a value of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) or less.

(b) Each eligible bona fide farmer is entitled to issue one order through the General Services Agency upon, or within, fourteen (14) days after, the successful completion of the processing of a registration renewal application. Each order shall be limited to a value of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) or less.
